



## WELCOME TO YOUR TRAVEL PLAN PACK

Here you will find information on how to take up more sustainable travel opportunities within your development and the local area.

As part of Sylvan Meadows, a Travel Plan has been produced which sets out the strategy in helping to encourage and increase the level of sustainable travel, as well as minimising the impact of development traffic on local roads and the environment. By promoting and monitoring the type of travel which takes place by residents, the Travel Plan will look to:

- Support a range of sustainable transport alternatives to provide the residents with options for sustainable travel to and from the site.
- Develop an awareness of the options for sustainable travel to and from the site and local area amongst residents.
- Promote car sharing, walking, cycling and public transport as safe, efficient, affordable alternatives to private cars and highlight the health and environmental benefits of using sustainable travel modes.
- Minimise the impact of car-based travel to the site on the local and strategic highway network and environment.

## YOUR LOCAL AREA

Sylvan Meadows provides 131 new homes to the west of Tye Lane, Walberton. The development is a 6-minute walk and 2-minute cycle ride from Walberton village centre where retail, education and leisure facilities can be accessed. Barnham is a 7-minute cycle of Walberton and has further facilities, including a rail station and employment opportunities.

## WALKING AND CYCLING

There are a number of walking and cycling routes located within the vicinity of your development. The Street has footways on both sides of the carriageway providing a key pedestrian route into Walberton village centre.

Cycling is appropriate on the surrounding roads in and around the village. A cycleway commences on Eastergate Lane, with a shared footway / cycleway providing a connection into Slindon.

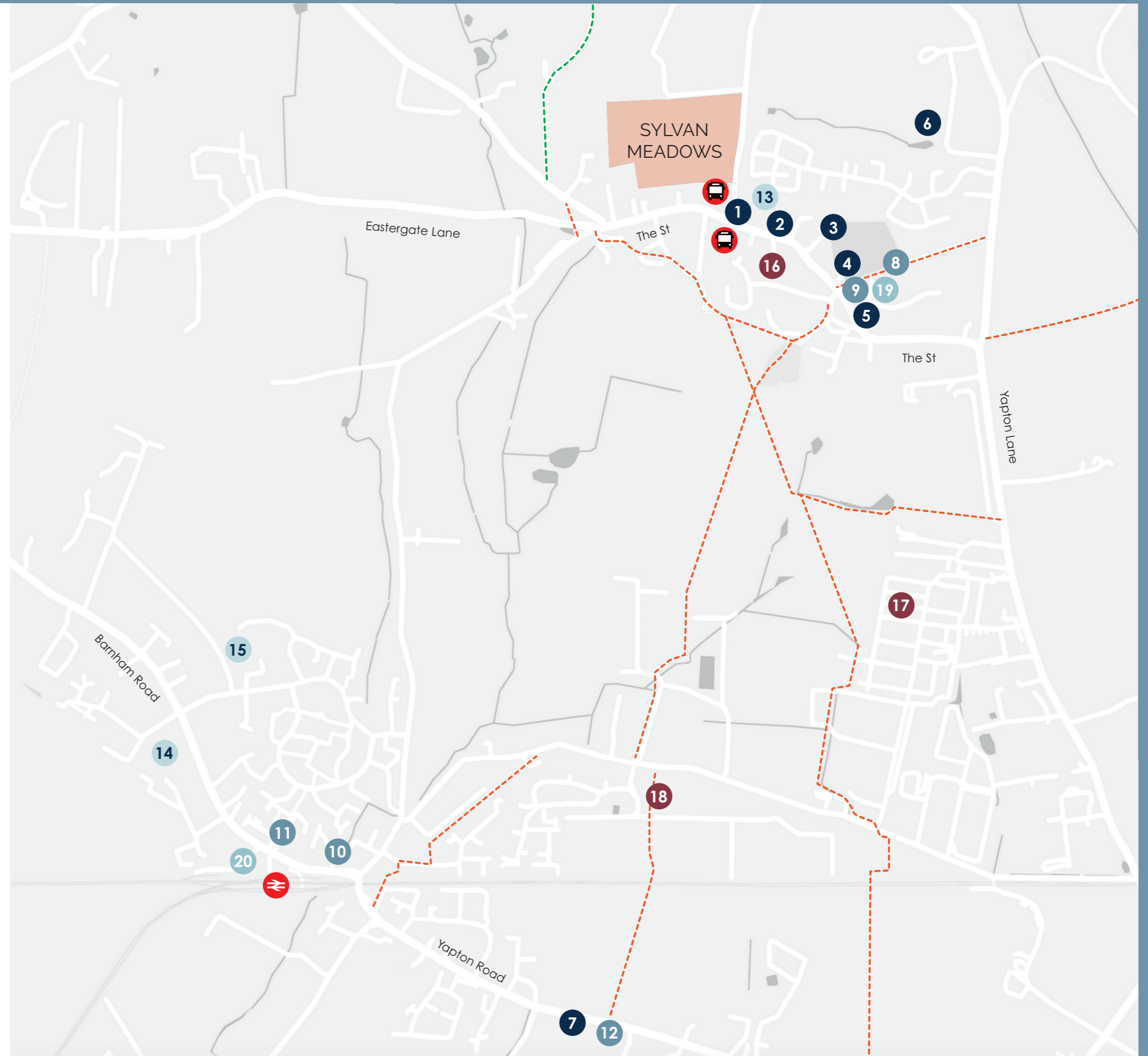

### CAR SHARING

## PUBLIC TRANSPORT

### BUS TRAVEL

Bus service 85 runs three services a day Monday to Friday whilst bus service 66a runs four services a day Monday to Friday and three services a day on Saturday from the bus stops located on The Street to the south of your development. These services provide access into Arundel, Barnham, Chichester and Bognor Regis.

### RAIL TRAVEL

Barnham Rail Station is your closest station, located to the southwest of Sylvan Meadows and provides opportunities to travel to Bognor Regis Littlehampton, Brighton, Chichester, Portsmouth, Southampton and London. Barnham Station provides 62 cycle spaces and a 130 space car park with step free access to all platforms.

## WHAT'S NEXT?

As part of the planning application for the development, a Travel Plan document was prepared which sets out the objectives and benefits of sustainable travel and the overall scheme. This document also sets out the targets and measures which the development will look to achieve over a 5 year monitoring period.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys and multi-modal surveys throughout the monitoring period and will help to determine the different forms of travel undertaken by residents and understand any barriers to particular travel modes. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan and allow for any changes to be made.

The results of the questionnaires and monitoring reports will be uploaded to the Travel Plan website.

As part of the Travel Plan, each household is entitled to one travel voucher worth up to £150. With flexible options available, you have the opportunity to choose a Compass Travel bus pass, a Southern Rail season ticket or a contribution towards cycling equipment.
